Regulation No. 7-498 (#3153)
Environmental Quality Board
Radiological Health and Radon Certification
Fees; Pennsylvania Radon Mitigation System
Tag and Fee

On June 16, 2016, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Environmental Quality Board (EQB). This rulemaking amends 25 Pa. Code Chapters 218 and 240. The proposed regulation was published in the July 2, 2016 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a public comment period ending August 30, 2016. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on July 19, 2017.


This regulation increases existing fees associated with the radioactive materials licensing and radon certification activities regulated by the Department of Environmental Protection Radiation Protection Program, and adds a requirement for a new radon mitigation system fee.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of EQB (35 P.S. §§ 7110.301, 7110.302 and 7110.401; 63 P.S. §§ 2008, 2012 and 2013) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
