On June 12, 2018, the Department of Labor and Industry (Department) delivered a proposed rulemaking package for Chapter 231 of 34 Pa. Code to update the executive, administrative and professional exemptions from the minimum wage and overtime requirement of the Minimum Wage Act of 1968.

The public comment period for this rulemaking is scheduled to end on July 23, 2018. The Department is requesting to extend this public comment period by 30 days or until August 22, 2018.
