Dear Chairman Bedwick:

On November 21, 2019, the Department of Labor & Industry (Department) withdrew the Notice of Final Form Rulemaking referenced above. At that time, the Department advised that it was withdrawing the rulemaking because of pending legislation that would invalidate portions of the regulation.

The House of Representatives has not considered and passed that legislation - Senate Bill 79 and the bill's fate is uncertain despite strong bipartisan support in the Senate. Therefore, the Department intends to resubmit Final Form Rulemaking 12-106 before the end of the year, for consideration at the January 30, 2020 meeting of the Independent Regulatory Review Commission.
