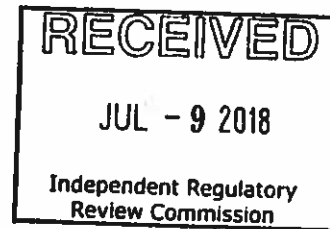

As a Licensed Massage Therapist working in the state of Pennsylvania, I am writing to strongly disagree with the proposal to increase the Biennial Renewal of License to \$200.

This increase is far too significant, especially considering the fees therapists must also pay for CE courses to keep their license current. This increase unnecessarily places the bulk of the burden for licensure on the backs of the working therapists who already give so much of themselves to the profession itself.

I urge you to reconsider the size of this increase and the repercussions of such a decision.
