

- 1. Journals
 - a. I would like to see a requirement to record the date of the document/instrument in the journal as was required under the Notary Public Law.
 - b. I would like to see a prohibition on skipping lines (or leaving them blank) and a requirement to cross blank lines out, so that additional information cannot subsequently be filled in.
 - c. Regarding electronic journals, I would like to see a requirement that puts the burden on the notary to prove their journal is tamper evident and cannot be altered after an entry has been completed.
- 2. Revocations
 - a. I would like to see a requirement that once revoked through a Final Adjudication and Order, a notary cannot apply for reappointment for a minimum of four years (the length of a commission).
