**Regarding 3270.31 4(i) First Aid Training – One -Time Professional Development in 10 Health and Safety areas**

It is written in the proposed regulations that "Any professional development sessions that have been completed within 2 years prior to the date of the publication of the final-form rulemaking will satisfy this requirement." The DHS has strongly suggested that Child Care facilities obtain this Health and Safety Basics training for almost 2 years now. Therefore, this window should go back further than 2 years so that this training can be counted for credit for staff who took this training back in December 2016.

**Regarding 3270.131(a), 3280.131(a) and 3290.131(a) (relating to health information)**

It is written in the proposed regulations that "The Department is proposing to **shorten the time frame to submit an initial health report from 60 days to 30 days**". Many families have trouble obtaining an appointment with their health care provider for a well child check within 30 days. Therefore, this shortened window will create a hardship for many families and potentially cause them to lose their childcare spot.

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
