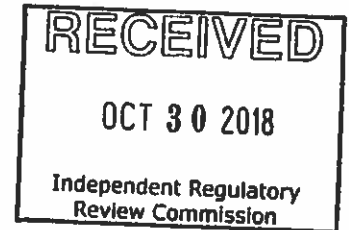

Subject: Proposed Changes to the Current Child Care Regulations



To whom it may concern,

I would like to make a suggestion on the certification process. Currently - one is required to take the "orientation" class when opening a "new location". A little over a year ago - my family and I moved less than a mile away - to a bigger home - primarily to increase the size of my family child care home. I had been previously licensed for 8 years and still had my original orientation certificate. (Which does not have on it the location address for which you are getting certification for.) I was told that since I was opening a new location - I must again repeat taking the orientation class. I found this a bit ridiculous since I was still located in the same state, the same county, and also the same township. This also required me to close a day so that I could go to Pittsburgh to complete the half day orientation class and receive the certificate that I needed. Even those teaching the orientation class wondered why this was necessary.

I feel that for someone else that may end up in the same circumstance - they should "not" be required to take the orientation class over again if they have already completed it and have a hard copy of their orientation certificate.
