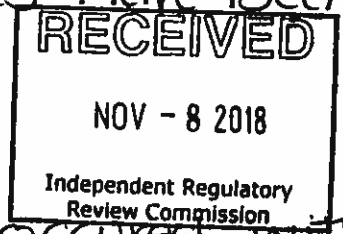


Introduction - crystal Price, LPC & NCC - "Lillianna's Voice"

- Lillianna - Born July 5, 2015
- our devastating experience occurred within the second week of her child care experience
 - During nap-time she was placed on her stomach.
(violation of 3270.119)
 - Lillianna cried for a reported 15-20 minutes
 - During that time no employees physically checked on her until 45-60 minutes later
 - By that time Lillianna was purple, breathless, and pulseless
 - I am proposing a regulation be made requiring 15-20 minute physical checks for napping infants
 - Virginia's regulation "22 VAC 40-185-30 D." states "resting or sleeping infants shall be individually checked every 15-20 minutes".
