- The Air Quality Program's expenses now exceed its revenue, which means the money being generated by the existing fee schedule is not adequate to fund the program.
- That revenue gap has resulted in a reduction in Air Quality Program staffing, which negatively affects the turnaround time for issuance of plan approvals and operating permits.
