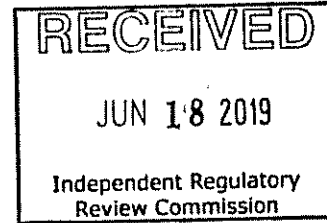

In the proposed rule, the Department considered three options for revising the Title V emission fee under §127.705 (relating to emissions fees). The Department goes on to propose Option 1, which would not increase the emission fee but implement an annual maintenance fee for Title V sources. U. S. Steel agrees with the proposal of Option 1, which U. S. Steel believes will spread the cost obligations in an equitable manner.
