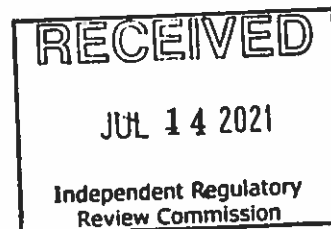

1. There is no way to register to be notified when an Online RAMP Class Open Enrollment will occur. One would have to keep checking the website to see if and when this will occur versus signing up to receive a notification as to when this happens.
2. The PLCB is not required to have an Online RAMP Class Approval Open Enrollment during the year. This means that the person/company would have to have already spent money and time to set up their class for approval, which may not become available for some time.
3. This is pointed out in the questions by the IRRC, "A potential applicant who prepares an online training module with no idea as to when open enrollment will occur has taken an unnecessary risk of his or her own making." This should not be.
4. I believe that PLCB should have a set open enrollment period(s) annually so that the applicants do not have to spend their time and money hoping and guessing if and when the PLCB may or may not have an open enrollment period.
