I am against the proposal to have Pennsylvania join the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI).

As the first mandatory cap-and-trade Program in the United States, and a cooperative effort among the states of Connecticut, Delaware, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island, Vermont, and Virginia, I believe it is imperative that the program be studied extensively, to include real-time short-term and long-term results, before Pennsylvania considers participation in RGGI.

The resulting carbon tax on employers could cost jobs, that have already been dramatically reduced due to recent shutdowns throughout Pennsylvania.
