I am also a proud member of CASA and for those who don't know what is CASA we're and organization that unites the latino and inmigrant community in Pennsylvania to make sure our voices are heard.

As a Puerto rican who has family that lost everything with the Hurricane Maria, I am aware of the economical and psychological impact that climate change is having in our daily lives. I am also a young dad of two years old daughter and I am extremely worried about climate change and how it is going to shape the way we live in the next 5 to 10 years.

As it says in the Commonwealth ``citizens of this commonwealth have an absolute right to clean air, pure water and preservation of the natural, scenic, historic and esthetic values of this environment'´ but in our communities the water and walls are with lead.
