Subject: [External] Comments and Suggestions on Proposed Changes

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I ask with all due respect for the following comments and suggestions to be considered regarding proposed regulatory changes.

1151.28 - should be able to sell edible products, also should add hashish, kief/separated trichomes and/or expand on the definition of oil to include them.

Obviously, including all ingredients and indicate if they're sourced from anything other than cannabis on the label. Too many grower-processers are using terpenes derived from things other than cannabis and are not telling patients.

1151.42 - should establish a means and procedure for patients to report to DoH on problematic products (seeds, fungus, and other products prohibited from being sold).

1161.27 - Since only DoH can approve devices to be sold in dispensaries, it should establish a means for patients to request devices for approval, similar to what it is for qualifying conditions, or better yet, do not make ANY restrictions on what devices can be used as long as they are legal. Allowing only dispensaries to sell these devices is getting too close to a monopoly, and dictating what can't be used is unnecessarily restrictive, cost-prohibitive, and denies access to higher quality and safer devices.

1161.28 - Include any allergen warnings (tree nut especially comes to mind for flavored vapes) on labels.

1161.30 (a) this should remain as it was. Changing this language prevents parents from bringing their children with them into a dispensary. This will negatively impact many parents who are patients, especially those that are single.

1171.31 - CoA/Lab results should be available to patients.

1181.28 - Should amend to allow for two-year certifications.
