For decades, our long-term care system has faced dwindling staffing, lower care standards, and cases of finad, abuse, and neglect. The result is a broken system that does not prioritize residents or caregivers, and led to Pennylvania having ene of the highest COVID maring home death rates in the entrie country.

These failures must be addressed. Updating Pennsylvania's archaic nursing home regulations, including the staffing standard, is an essential part of the reform we need.

Under the current regulations, residents are only required to receive 27 boars of care per day. For years, we have been calling for a new sole staffing standard Hing that requirement to 4.1 boars, which is the minimum standard recommended by dder care experts. The proposed regulations or mining boars system and potect residents and show who care for them.

I urge you to do everything in your power to support the Governor's sursing home regulation reform.
