I believe all charter schools, including cyber charter schools should:

- Follow generally accepted standards of fiscal management and audit requirements.
- Publicly list their trustees, held to basic ethical standards and disclose and abstain from any conflicts of interest.
- Annually submit a standardized charter application process that will allow charter authorizers to hold prospective charter schools to high academic, fiscal, and administrative standards.

Additionally, I support any efforts to produce a cyber charter funding formula that accurately reflects the true costs of offering a cyber education.
