También a tener la oportunidad de trabajar ocho horas. Mis jefes solamente hablan inglés y por eso tienen una barrera de lengua con ellos. No puedo comunicarme con los gerentes. Para mi y mi familia, yo acuerdo que la legislatura debe pasar HB 345 y aumentar el salario mínimo.

Hello, I am F and I live in Pittsburgh. I work four to five hours each day, Monday through Friday. I usually work from 5:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m. or 5:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. in the restaurant. I don't receive tips and I clean plates. I don't earn a lot of money and I want to work eight hours but I can't. I think that 15 dollars can help me. Also to have the opportunity to work eight hours. My managers only speak English and because of this there is a language barrier with them. I can't communicate with the managers. For myself and my family, I agree that the legislature should pass HB 345 and raise the minimum wage.
