I live in Bucks County, Langhorne, and my water currently has the following chemicals (all of which are cancer causing):

130x Bromodichloromethane;
66x Chloroform;
19x Chromium;
3.1x Dibromoacetic Acid;
22x Dibromochloromethane;
40x Dichloroacetic Acid;
247x Haloacetic Acids (HAA5);
418x Haloacetic Acids (HAA9);
228x Total Trihalomethanes;
112x Trichloroacetic Acid

I've looked around other counties in Pa and they have the same or even worse things going on in their water. A lot of them have nuclear waste in their damn drinking water. This is unacceptable. Pennsylvania (as well as the rest of the country) needs a complete water system

overhaul. I don't even dare give this water to my pets! Please acknowledge and address this problem. We are not a third world country. But when you look at our water system you'd sure thing we were. Thank you for listening.
