The Warminster Municipal Authority (Authority) supports a science-based approach to setting limits for PFAS chemicals in drinking water. We understand the limits and accept these proposed limits for regulated water systems. The Authority, however, has rejected these standards for customers of the Authority due to historical levels consumed by our customers and the science showing additional bioaccumulation for PFAS chemicals even at low levels. Our MCLG is zero.

We hope elevated levels of PFAS chemicals remain rare for water systems and community water suppliers providing life-sustaining water. For the unfortunate communities finding PFAS contamination, we urge the PADEP to assist and support these water providers.

If PADEP finds communities needing PFAS treatment, the Authority has a wealth of experience and will remain supportive of any community needing PFAS treatment assistance.
