My sister died in July 2022, and she received first-rate, compassionate care there while she was dying (and also before that, while she was battling cancer). Since the 2022 DOH survey found Gwynedd House to be deficiency free, and since we receive no funding from Medicare, why should there be any need for us to do Medicare paperwork?
