

INDEPENDENT REGULATORY REVIEW COMMISSION

2017 ANNUAL REPORT



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Pennsylvania's General Assembly created the Independent Regulatory Review Commission to provide independent oversight of the rulemaking process in Pennsylvania and to establish an ongoing and effective review of agency regulations. The Commission's mission is to review agency regulations in order to determine whether they are in the public interest. By evaluating the conformity of rulemakings with law, and their impact on the public and regulated community, we assist the General Assembly and the Governor in achieving a favorable regulatory balance and ensure the integrity of the regulatory process. This annual report details the Commission's activities in 2017.

In 2017, the Commission reviewed a total of 53 regulations, including 31 proposed and 22 final regulations. More than 230 public comments were submitted on pending regulations in 2017. 32 members of the House and Senate submitted comments on these regulations. Standing Committees submitted formal comments on one rulemaking.

Notable regulations reviewed by the Commission in 2017 include: Gasoline Volatility Requirements (Environmental Quality Board #3162); Home and Community-Based Supports and Licensing (Department of Human Services #3160); and Securities Regulation Omnibus Amendments (Department of Banking and Securities #3152). A full list of the regulations reviewed by the Commission in 2017 is attached.

Looking ahead, the Commission will continue its role as an independent oversight body reviewing agency regulations and determining whether the criteria set forth in Pennsylvania's Regulatory Review Act have been satisfied.

Requires all vehicles proposed for medallion taxicab service after a designated date to be wheelchair accessible and comply with the wheelchair accessible regulations, including vehicle age and mileage requirements.
