Pennsylvania's General Assembly created the Independent Regulatory Review Commission to provide independent oversight of the rulemaking process in Pennsylvania and to establish an ongoing and effective review of agency regulations. The Commission's mission is to review agency regulations in order to determine whether they are in the public interest. By evaluating the conformity of rulemakings with law, and their impact on the public and regulated community, we assist the General Assembly and the Governor in achieving a favorable regulatory balance and ensure the integrity of the regulatory process. This annual report details the Commission's activities in 2019.

In 2019, the Commission reviewed a total of 49 regulations, including 26 proposed and 23 final regulations. More than 2,270 public comments were submitted on pending regulations in 2019. 7 comments were submitted by legislative standing committees and 105 members of the House and Senate submitted comments on these regulations.

Notable regulations reviewed by the Commission in 2019 include: Unfair Market Trade Practices (Office of Attorney General #3242); Minimum Wage and Overtime Requirements (Department of Labor and Industry #3202); Privacy of Consumer Financial Information (Department of Insurance #3207); and Intensive Behavioral Health Services (Department of Human Services #3209).

Looking ahead, the Commission will continue its role as an independent oversight body reviewing agency regulations and determining whether the criteria set forth in Pennsylvania's Regulatory Review Act have been satisfied.
