Regulation No.7-358
Environmental Quality Board
Interim Enhanced Surface Water Treatment

On August 8, 2000, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Environmental Quality Board (Board). This rulemaking amends 25 Pa. Code Chapter 109. The proposed regulation was published in the September 2, 2000 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on May 8, 2001.

This rulemaking establishes Cryptosporidium removal requirements, water filtritration standards and disinfection benchmarks to assure sufficient protection from waterborne bacterial pathogens.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Board (35 P.S. § 721.4(a)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
