Pursuant to Section 5(b.2) of the Regulatory Review Act (Act 1982-181), the House of Representatives' Education Committee met on Wednesday, February 7, 2001, to consider comments on the Department's proposed rulemaking #6-271. At that meeting, the Committee voted to send the following comment:

This Committee notes that the proposed regulations define and use throughout the text the phrases "<u>eligible</u> school lunch" and "<u>eligible</u> school breakfast". (Emphasis added.) The enabling statute, (Act 16 of 2000), on the other hand, uses the phrases "school lunch" and "school breakfast". This Committee suggests that the Department provide an explanation of the inadequacy of the statutory language for regulatory purposes when responding to comments in its submittal of final-form rulemaking. While there is good reason to add the word "eligible" as a measure of compliance with federal program standards, we feel the department should explain the difference.

Apart from the above comment, this Committee found no conflict between these regulations and the enabling statute, Act 16 of 2000.

On behalf of the Committee, we commend the Department for its assistance in this matter and for providing John Godliewski and Pat Birkenshaw to address the Committee members' questions at our meeting. If I can assist you further with our comments, please contact me.
