Regulation No. 7-415 (#2624) Environmental Quality Board Alternative Fuels Incentive Grant Program (AFIG) Regulation

On August 13, 2007, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this regulation from the Environmental Quality Board. This rulemaking deletes 4 Pa. Code Chapter 311. Notice of proposed rulemaking was omitted for this regulation; it will become effective upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

This final-omitted regulation deletes 4 Pa. Code Chapter 311 (Chapter 311) titled "Alternative Fuels Incentive Grant Fund" (Fund) in its entirety. Act 178 of 2004 (Act 178) repealed the statute cited as the authority for Chapter 311 and abrogated regulations promulgated under it. The Fund will continue to be in existence, but will be administered using the provisions in Act 178 rather than Chapter 311.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Environmental Quality Board (Section 8 of Act 178 of 2004) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
