

RE: 25 Code Chapter 95  
Wastewater Treatment Requirements

Please do not allow the gas industry dilute the proposed new regulations on TDS discharges into Pennsylvania's waters.

As the 2 Bucknell scientists noted at the Lycoming College summit, we do not know enough about the long term effects of frackwater discharges, e.g., heavy salt concentrations poured into fresh water streams, nor does any existing technology, including membranes, produce water that meets EPA standards for TDS.

So why allow irreparable damage to be done to Pennsylvania's waterways? We are not still living in the days of coal barons, but we are still paying for their profiteering.
