

Dear Environmental Quality Board Members:

I should like to express my hope that you will recognize the importance of regulation that will set standards to protect streams from gas well wastewater and require gas drillers to limit the pollution in their wastewater discharges, specifically total dissolved solids pollution. These regulations are needed now before drilling in the Marcellus Shale increases. The water quality problems from high levels of total dissolved solids including fish kills and contamination of drinking water are already occurring.
