I am concerned about the proposed changes to title 28, chapter 23 of the Pennsylvania Code.

Since parents are not required to immunize their children until the children are admitted into school, the provisional period of 5 days for parents to obtain any necessary vaccines is far too short in the event that a student should require several vaccines. Parents should have more time to develop a plan for their children to receive the required vaccines.

Children who have been infected by varicella should not be required to receive the chicken pox vaccine. A written statement from the parents should be treated as sufficient evidence demonstrating a history of chickenpox.
