Regulation No. 18-477 (#3258)
Department of Transportation
Registration Class Stickers

On May 18, 2020, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Department of Transportation (Department). This rulemaking deletes 67 Pa. Code Chapter 55. The proposed regulation was published in the May 30, 2020 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a public comment period ending on June 29, 2020. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on October 26, 2021.

This final-form rulemaking rescinds the requirement that registration class stickers that indicate the registered gross weight of certain trucks be affixed to those trucks.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Transportation (75 Pa.C.S. §§ 1301, 1304(b) and 6103) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
