Subject: DOH Proposed Regulation #10-242

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Changes requiring schools to “permit the Department or local health authority to meet and speak with a student or other person, in private,” and may not interfere with a minor’s consent under 35 P.S. § 10103, which the Department interprets to mean “the consent of no other person shall be necessary.” If adopted, this would enable private interactions with Department officials and students (even if the student is a minor) and potential coercion and treatments (including vaccinations) of minors without parental knowledge or consent, undermining parental rights and creating risks of medically contraindicated interventions that could harm students. This removes the parents from the being involved with the treatment of their children. This is not an emergency situation.

This should not be adopted.
