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To the Independent Regulatory Review Commission and the Pennsylvania Department of Health,

I am writing to express my absolute opposition to proposed Regulation #10-242 (IRRC #3490) regarding Communicable and Noncommunicable Diseases.

I object entirely to this regulatory rewrite and reject the expansion of state power over personal medical privacy and parental authority.

Specifically, I oppose:

1. **Mandatory Reporting and Data Collection:** The government has no business monitoring, collecting, or maintaining state databases of my child's private immunization records or medical health status. Mandatory reporting requirements violate individual medical privacy and erode patient-doctor confidentiality.
2. **Infringement on Religious Freedom:** I strongly object to any regulatory changes or statutory shifts that restrict, complicate, or undermine a parent's constitutional and legal right to exercise religious or moral exemptions to vaccination requirements. Parents hold the sole right to make medical decisions for their children according to their personal, religious, and moral convictions.
3. **Unconsented Student Access and Interrogations:** I object to any provision that grants health department officials, school staff, or government entities the authority to contact, interview,

test, or evaluate minor children in school settings—or access their records for contact tracing—without express, prior, written consent from their parents.

Parents possess the primary authority and fundamental obligation to govern the healthcare, privacy, and personal interactions of their children. The Department of Health must not bypass parental consent or establish systemic state oversight over personal health choices.

I urge the Independent Regulatory Review Commission to reject Regulation #10-242 in its entirety.
