Subject: Proposed Regulation #10-242 – Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases

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To Whom it May Concern:

I am writing to express my opposition to proposed legislation [#10-242: Communicable and Non-Communicable Disease](#).

This proposal is unconstitutional, infringes on individual privacy, and concentrates decision-making authority in the hands of a limited group of individuals. This is granting them power over another person's constitutional rights. Public health objectives must follow a least-restrictive approach, limited in scope and applied only to measures reasonably necessary to protect Pennsylvania residents. This legislation does the opposite.

I am not in favor of the following provisions:

1. Expansion of executive authority beyond reasonable public health necessity.
2. Infringement on personal rights through surveillance and collection of PHI that exceeds what is required for public safety.
3. Authorization of involuntary isolation or quarantine without evidence-based justification or appropriate legal review.
4. Permitting confinement without defined scope, duration, or conditions that ensure transparent and accountable decision-making.
