Pennsylvania's General Assembly created the Independent Regulatory Review Commission to provide independent oversight of the rulemaking process in Pennsylvania and to establish an ongoing and effective review of agency regulations. The Commission's mission is to review agency regulations in order to determine whether they are in the public interest. By evaluating the conformity of rulemakings with law, and their impact on the public and regulated community, we assist the General Assembly and the Governor in achieving a favorable regulatory balance and ensure the integrity of the regulatory process. This annual report details the Commission's activities in 2015.

In 2015, the Commission reviewed a total of 74 regulations, including 42 proposed and 32 final regulations. More than 4,100 public comments were submitted on pending regulations in 2015. 17 members of the House and Senate submitted comments on these regulations. Standing Committees submitted formal comments on nine rulemakings.

Notable regulations reviewed by the Commission in 2015 include: Modern Taxicab Standards (Philadelphia Parking Authority #3103 and Public Utility Commission #3033); Responsible Alcohol Management Program (Liquor Control Board #3093); and Collaborative Management of Drug Therapy (State Board of Pharmacy #3006). A full list of regulations received by the Commission in 2015 is attached.

Looking ahead, the Commission will continue its role as an independent oversight body reviewing agency regulations and determining whether the criteria set forth in Pennsylvania's Regulatory Review Act have been satisfied.
