I. CALL OF THE MEETING

The June 18, 2026 public meeting of the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) was called to order by Chairman Bedwick at 10:00 a.m. in the 8th Floor Conference Room, 555 Walnut Street, Harrisburg, PA.

III. APPROVAL OF THE APRIL 23, 2026 PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES

2. **No. 3407 State Board of Veterinary Medicine #16A-5732: Fee Increase**
