## PROCEDURES FOR DELIVERY AND SUBMISSION OF FINAL REGULATIONS

To assist agencies in delivering and submitting their final-form and final-omitted regulations, we have prepared a checklist of tasks to complete when delivering and submitting a regulatory package. These requirements are in the Commission's regulations, at 1 Pa. Code, Chapters 307.2 and 307.3.

## **DELIVERY OF A FINAL-FORM REGULATION**

	beliver the final-form regulation and other required materials to the standing committees and the Commission.	
f	end, by first class or electronic mail, a notice of submission and a copy of the text of the nal-form regulation or a copy of all changes to the proposed regulation which are accorporated into the final-form regulation, to commentators who requested information in the final-form regulation.	
Include the foll	owing documents with the regulation:	
_	The completed regulatory analysis form;	
_	The face sheet signed by the Office of General Counsel or chief counsel of an independent agency;	
	The agency's response to the comments received;	
_	A list of names and addresses of commentators who requested additional information on the final-form regulation;	
_	The preamble;	
_	The text of the final-form regulation; and	
_	The transmittal sheet signed by the standing committees.	
Ensure that the text of the final-form regulation conforms to the following format:		
_	Brackets – to indicate language that was proposed to be deleted from the existing regulation.	
_	Underscoring – to indicate any new language that was proposed to be added to the existing regulation.	
_	Strikeout type - to indicate any language in the existing or proposed regulation which is deleted in the final-form.	
_	Capital letters - to indicate any new language which was not included in the existing or proposed regulation.	

## **DELIVERY OF A FINAL-OMITTED REGULATION**

On the same date:			
	Deliver a final-omitted regulation to the standing committees, the Attorney General and the Commission on the same date.		
Include the following documents with the regulation:			
		The completed regulatory analysis form;	
		The face sheet signed by the Office of General Counsel or chief counsel of an independent agency;	
		The preamble;	
		The text of the final-omitted regulation; and	
		The transmittal sheet signed by the standing committees and the Office of Attorney General.	
Ensure that the text of the final-form regulation conforms to the following format:			
		Brackets – to indicate language deleted from the existing regulation.	
	-	Underscoring – to indicate language added to the existing regulation.
